



The Rhythm of the Learner Year Timeline








What to Expect from Ed Directions

The State Change Initiative: Standards-based Teaching and Learning






- Support the ongoing rollout of the new standards

- Provide ad hoc professional development




The State Change Initiative: Local Context

- Professional development and PLC Assistance








Student as Learner vs.
Student as Performer




Core research -How Students Learn and Perform



Core Research – How Students Learn






5 Legged Model of Student Performance



What is the Rhythm of the Learner Year?

Ed Directions research base emphasizes the need to honor the learner in planning programs and curriculum

- The Opening Period
- The Formative Period
- The Calibrating Period
- The Testing Period
- End of Year (EOY) Period
- The Summer Period


Opening of School Period

Timeframe: 2 weeks before school opens

to 3 weeks after school opens

The Priorities:

- Enculturing
- Preparing all students for success in class
- Mastering management and academic rituals and routines
- Building adult access to students
- Establishing work and performance expectations
- Jump starting critical reading, thinking and writing




The Formative Period

Timeframe: Week 3 to the beginning of winter break

The Priorities:

- Building an independent learner
- Increasing potential as performer
- Building operational language
- Using critical reading, writing and thinking strategies
- Building basic reading and performing competencies
- Building a best effort comfort zone
